

Budget Energy ‘Keypad – Powershift’ Tariff

Scope of Agreement

1. These terms apply to the Budget Energy ‘Keypad Powershift’ Tariff, (“the *Tariff*”). The eligibility criteria to avail of the Tariff are as follows:-
 - You must be a domestic electricity customer in Northern Ireland with a keypad meter; and
 - You must agree to only use a keypad meter for the supply of your electricity.
2. These terms are in addition to the Budget Energy Ltd General Terms and Conditions for the Supply of Electricity to Metered Premises – Domestic Customers (“*Budget Energy’s General Terms and Conditions*”) (as may be amended from time to time and which can be found on our website at www.budgetenergy.co.uk or obtained by calling us on Freephone 0800 012 11 77) and the Budget Energy Ltd Customer Agreement Form (“*CAF*”). Collectively these terms, the Budget Energy General Terms and Conditions and the CAF are referred to as the “*Agreement*”.
3. In the event of any conflict between these terms, the Budget Energy General Terms and Conditions and the CAF, these terms will apply.

4. **Powershift Low Rate: Monday to Friday Midnight to 8am; Saturday and Sunday 7pm to 8am**
Powershift Normal Rate: Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm and 7pm to Midnight; Saturday and Sunday 8am to 7pm
Powershift Peak Rate: Monday to Friday 4pm to 7pm
The discount is not applied to the Standing Charge.
5. The method of payment shall be prepayment top ups to the keypad meter. These top ups can be purchased via our Budget Energy App, online, via automated phone service or at outlets where ‘Paypoint’ or ‘Payzone’ payment processing services are available.
6. If you move house during the Agreement Term, you may continue to avail of this Tariff for the remainder of the Agreement Term for electricity supply at your new address, providing you continue to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in paragraph 1 above.

Ending This Agreement

7. If, at any time, you do not meet the eligibility criteria, as set out in paragraph 1 above, Budget Energy Ltd reserve the right to end this agreement and transfer you to the most appropriate tariff at that time and you will be notified of any change using your chosen method of communication.
8. You may cancel the Tariff during the 10 working days from when the Agreement is first made (“*Cooling Off Period*”) by calling us on Freephone 0800 012 11 77, by e-mail to customerservice@budgetenergy.co.uk or by writing to us by post to ‘30-32 Balliniska Road, Derry/Londonderry, BT48 0LY’.

Variations to this Agreement

9. Budget Energy Ltd reserves the right to amend the electricity unit rates or charges that apply to the Tariff at any time during the Term if there is a cost imposed upon Budget Energy Ltd by a governmental or statutory body (including a change in VAT) or as otherwise provided for in the Budget Energy General Terms & Conditions. If your tariff rate changes during the term we will notify you 21 calendar days in advance using your chosen method of communication.
10. Tariff discounts may not be used in conjunction with any other Budget Energy Ltd electricity offer, discount or tariff, unless otherwise specified by Budget Energy Ltd during your registration and/or on your CAF.
11. Budget Energy Ltd reserves the right to withdraw the Tariff without notice at any time prior to the start of the Term.
